Frequently asked questions

Q: How do I install Deziner Panels Timber products?

A: For installation of our Timber panels please see below:

Tools required for installation:

- Spirit level - tape measure - Phillips head screw driver/cordless drill - fixing nail gun(not framing gun)
- Hammer - liquid nails

Mark the walls with straight lines across the surface you wish to cover the same distance apart as the timber panels you are going to hang. Use these lines as a guide to keep the panels straight and square



Apply liquid nails or non acidic silicone with a silicone gun or timber glue with a notched trowel to the wall area



Press the Timber panel firmly against the wall making sure that it is square and the gaps between each panel is closed tight



To gain a more secure fix to the wall, use a fixing gun (NOT a framing gun) to shoot a fixing nail through gaps in the timber pieces (uses some masking on the face of the fixing gun in case it leaves damage on the panels) or use timber bugle screws between the gaps if you choose (please note that the screws will be visible if they are not coloured to match the timber panels)



For a brick wall installation you will need to build a small batter stud wall against the bricks. Then line the stud wall with plywood or you could line the wall with direct stick plaster board (you will need to shoot the fixing gun on a 45 deg angle to make sure the nail grabs the plaster and doesn't bounce back from hitting the brick wall).



Then begin installation of the Timber panels as previously mentioned.

Q: Are Deziner panels Timber products temperature/moisture resistant?

A: Our Timber Panels are designed for indoor and outdoor installations. When using our Timber panels for an outdoor installation, the panels will require 2 coats of Water base Outdoor UV satin protection (Cabots).

Q: How do I clean the Timber Panels?

A: You can clean the timber products with a feather duster or a damp rag.

Q: Can Deziner panels Timber products be damaged or break if something is dropped on them or hit with an object?

A: Our Timber panels are made from recycled timber from old ships and boats. Although they are very durable please DO NOT hit them with any objects or drop them as they are made up of many small timber pieces and they will break/fall off the base of the panel if hit hard enough.

Q: Is this product flammable?

A: The panel material can be ignited by a flame or a smouldering ignition. The panels should only be installed if it is safe to do so. Checking the manufactures instructions of heating appliances is a must and should be done by the customer prior to ordering our timber panels.

Q: Can the Timber panels be re painted/ stained?

A: Yes our Timber panels can be re stained if the customer wants to. We use water base stains to coat our panels.

Q: Does Deziner panels Timber products come with a warranty?

A: Yes, our products come with a 12 month warranty which covers:

- Abnormal damage during “ normal ” use of the product otherwise stated in this document

The warranty does not cover:

- Any damage due to an incorrect installation of the product otherwise stated in this document
- Any damage to the products during delivery from outside sources other than the Deziner Panels team of installers.
- Any miss use of the product otherwise stated in this document

Deziner Panels Australia Pty Ltd will not cover or be liable for any transportation fees and installation fees if replacement of the product is required due to loss or miss use of the product.
